Catherine Blue died February 6, 2012 at Lutheran Hospital. She was a member of First Presbyterian Church and retired from the Engineering Dept. at General Electric. She had a great love for music and singing. Cathy was a 50 year Honorary Life member of AAUW and belonged to the Current Literature II group for many years. Cathy, whose Memorial Service was at the Towne House Chapel, had no survivors.

Genevieve Mae Sinish died February 22, 2012 at Visiting Nurse & Hospice Home. She was a 50 year Honorary Life member of AAUW and had been quite active in this Branch. She served as Historian, Study Group Coordinator, and was Chair of the workers for the Book Sale as well as State Fellowship Chair. Genevieve was named Woman of the Year in 1985, grant winner three times (1994, 1996, and 2004), served on many committees, and was in many Interest Groups.
